Re: Renewal, Additional, and Removal of Certification and Additional Certification Under Ohio's Voluntary Action Program

Dear Ms. Earle:

Upon review of your laboratory's application for renewal of certification under Ohio's Voluntary Action Program, I am pleased to inform you that the laboratory meets the applicable requirements. Therefore, the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (the "Director") has renewed the laboratory's certification under the authority of Ohio Revised Code ("ORC") 3746.04(B)(6) and Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") 3745-300-04.

In addition to requesting renewal, your application included a request to add Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) by Method TO15 and to remove air and soil gas testing for VOCs by Methods 8260A and 8260B. The Director has reviewed this request and has issued additional certification for Volatile Organic Compounds by method TO15A, in addition to approving your request to remove air and soil gas testing from Volatile Organic Compounds method 8260A and 8260B. Your laboratory certification number remains CL0022.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after the notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director with in three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed with the Environmental Review Appeals Commission at the following address:


